
In 2000, Franco founded his own Company, Dragone, marked by two big successes in Las Vegas: first, A New Day... with Céline Dion, and then Le Rêve.



In June 2013, Yves Delacolette became the President of Dragone. Together, Franco and Yves are on a mission to take the Company well beyond the existing, charted waters, and make Dragone the greatest cultural creation company in the world. With shows soon opening in Mainland China, Paris, Dubai and Jakarta, just to name a few, the next decade will undoubtedly be the most creative of Franco's life, and the most interesting for Dragone's audiences, partners and teams. 




The repertoire includes a unique and original set of performances of Dragone, under the Artistic Direction of Franco Dragone.


popular opera arias and classical Neapolitan compositions alongside contemporary songs arranged and performed according to the aesthetics and traditions of the original Italian "Belcanto".













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Preliminary Tableaux
